Beatings & Tear-Gas, Blood, Broken Bones & Illegal Detentions at 'La Puya', Guatemala, On Behalf of American and Canadian Mining Companies

On May 14, the people of San Pedro Ayampuc and San Pedro del Golfo received our UNBC / Rights Action group at the "La Puya" community resistance site. They fed us lunch, and told us of 2 years of peaceful resistance to the illegal and repressive mining interests of the American company Kappes, Cassidy Associates (KCA), formerly owned by Canadian Radius Gold. (Radius maintains profit sharing interests in any future mining profits.)



On May 23, the Guatemalan regime – headed by former General Otto Perez Molina – ordered hundreds of anti-riot police to break apart the "La Puya" resistance camp. Result: tear-gas and beatings; cracked ribs, blood, dozens in hospital, and at least 4 illegally detain (political prisoners).

<u>Today's repression is due in large part</u> to the unquestioning support the Canadian and U.S. governments give to North American companies (Goldcorp Inc, Tahoe Resources, Hudbay Minerals, KCA, Radius Gold) that, in Guatemala, depend almost solely on repression by the regime to illegally advance and protect their mining interests.
