The violence and repression, corruption and impunity of Honduras are American and Canadian issues. The U.S. and Canadian governments, the World Bank and Inter-American Development Bank, and North American companies and investors (including pension funds) maintain profitable economic and military relations with the Honduran regime, most particularly since the 2009 military coup, turning a blind eye to the now endemic violence and repression, corruption and impunity that force so many to flee.
