Tegucigalpa.- The body of the young environmentalist, Luis Fernando Ayala (16 years old), was found early Tuesday morning in the Concepcion del Sur hamlet in the Gualala Municipality in the Department of Santa Barbara.

Ayala was a member of the Santa Barbara Environmental Movement (Movimiento Ambientalista Santabarbarense – MAS). According to the reports of local human rights defenders, he had been tortured and both of his hands had been amputated.

This young environmentalist was strongly opposed to the mining and hydroelectric projects that have been invading the area.

Ayala and his family have been active members of the Santa Barbara Environmentalist Movement –MAS- in the Gualala Municipality, which has struggled against gypsum mining concessions for over three years. This concession was granted indefinitely, and threatens to disappear the Arenales community in this municipality.

Of the protests that have taken place in Santa Barbara since the elections, those led by MAS have been severely criminalized and persecuted by members of the military and the police, including cases of assassination.

What are the U.S. and Canadian governments doing – while maintaining full political, economic and military relations with the Honduran regime – to pressure Honduras to free Edwin and all political prisoners, to drop all the trumped up charges, and to stop the political killings and assassinations?
