# Junior Javier Rivas Rivas shot ten times, body burned, left for all to fear in Honduras

The Honduras Solidarity Network (HSN) reports that 23-year old, Junior Javier Rivas Rivas - a member of the LIBRE party and Honduras' popular resistance to the post-coup regimes - was murdered April 28, 2019, in Tegucigalpa, capital city of Honduras. According to press reports, Rivas Rivas was shot 10 times and then his body was burned in the La Esperanza neighborhood.

In 2016, during a LIBRE protest against the privatization of Honduran highways, Rivas Rivas was arrested along with 13 others. He was an active member of the popular citizen resistance to the military-backed regimes in power since the 2009 military coup.

The violent way in which he was killed and the next to impossible chance that the murder will be properly investigated, generates further terror amongst the Honduran movement and population.

Rest in peace, Junior Javier. Our condolences to his family and friends. (HSN)

#### This is how Honduras operates

This is one more of 100s of state sanctioned killings since the 2009 U.S. and Canadian backed coup.

Edwin Espinal - spouse of Canadian human rights activist Karen Spring - is being illegally held as a political prisoner in a max-security military jail (since January 2018) because he was protesting the systemic state killings, human rights violations, corruption and impunity since the 2009 coup.

This is why 10s of 1000s of Honduras are forced to flee their homes and country, every year since the 2009 coup, and why many more are fleeing right now.

## This will not stop

As long as the U.S., Canada and the "international community" maintain full economic, military and political relations with the corrupt, repressive government in power in Honduras, this will not stop.
